Dr. Tuffuor has founded a rural medical center in Ghana that includes clinics and an 80 bed hospital. He would welcome medical students from CWRU at his medical center. Fourth year students would function as clerks in the clinics and wards. Preclinical students could carry out short-term research projects. Supervision would be provided by staff physicians working at the medical center.
