Intensive One-On-One Classes

Spend an intensive but enjoyable 25 hours a week studying with your own private teacher. You'll receive extensive instruction and practice in conversation, grammar, reading, and writing. Students of all levels excel with our approach, from complete beginners to highly advanced. In addition, you'll learn about the realities of life in Guatemala and Latin America.

Homestay

You'll live with a Guatemalan family and experience life in a different culture. Often you'll be invited to go to the market or participate in other family activities.

Activities

Trips to villages, schools, factories, collectives, markets, and hot springs; conferences led by experts in civil rights and Mayan culture; Salsa and Meringue dance classes; documentaries and discussions; these are just some of the after-class activities that are included. Learn, have fun, and get a chance to use the Spanish you've been studying in real situations.

Volunteer Programs

We're extensively and directly involved in volunteer projects aimed at improving life in Guatemala. Teach primary school in a rural mountain village, work on a collective coffee farm, provide health care, or work with our on site rural development organization YUN Q'AX. These programs and more help you to improve your Spanish while giving to the community.

Medical Spanish Option

Medical and nursing school students get direct hands-on clinical experience providing health care to poor rural populations. You'll be able to strengthen your clinical skills and command of Spanish while helping people who might otherwise not receive any medical treatment. An intermediate level of Spanish is required for clinic participation, but if you need to improve your Spanish you may do so at the school before starting your placement. All levels integrate medical terminology into daily classes. Many Universities grant elective or clinical rotation credit for participation in our program.
