He was also a founding member of the U.S. Commerce Department's National Advisory Council on Innovation and Entrepreneurship (NACIE), and currently serves on the board of Invent Now, a nonprofit organization which educates 100,000 U.S. children each summer in science, technology, engineering and math.



Ms. Gloria Ware leads JumpStart's strategic efforts to create inclusive, high-impact entrepreneurial ecosystems. She has a 25-year track record of success in the banking industry, providing financing and cash flow management solutions to a portfolio of small businesses, public entities, non-profit organizations, private schools and universities. Prior to joining JumpStart, she was Vice President of Public Funds at Fifth Third Bank where she participated in the sourcing, execution and maintenance of more than \$100 million in debt underwriting and interest rate hedging transactions.
