



## Printing Screens from the SIS

The Student Information System (SIS) does not support the printing of pages from the browser **Print** button. If you try to print a SIS screen from an Internet browser, the printed page will be blank or show only the header of the page.


There are a few ways to manipulate printing options in Internet Explorer and Firefox that will allow you to print full pages from the SIS.






### Internet Explorer

#### Option 1



<p>1. Right click your mouse on the screen and select <b>Print</b>.</p>	
<p>2. The Print window will appear. Select your printer and click the <b>Print</b> button.</p>	

#### Option 2

<p>1. Right click your mouse on the page and click <b>Select all</b>.</p>

<p>2. In IE 9: Select <b>Tools, Print</b>, then <b>Print Preview</b>.</p> <p>In IE 8: Select <b>File</b>, then <b>Print Preview</b>.</p>	
<p>3. The Print Preview window appears. Click the second dropdown box from the left and select <b>As selected on screen</b>.</p>	
<p>4. Click the last dropdown box from the left and select <b>Shrink to fit</b> (if it doesn't appear already).</p>	
<p>5. Click the <b>Print</b> button on the top left.</p>	
<p>6. The Print window will appear. Select your printer and click the Print button.</p>	

## Mozilla Firefox

<p>1. Right click your mouse on the screen.</p>	
<p>2. Place your mouse over <b>This Frame</b> and select <b>Print Frame</b>.</p>	

3. The print dialog box will appear. Select your printer and click **OK**.
