











Work Trip Mode Split – University Circle

A person can reduce his or her chance of being in an accident by more than 90% by taking public transit as oppose to commuting by car. (Litman, 2016)




The average person loses 13 lbs in the first year commuting by bike. (International Bike Fund, 2017)
