Currently a senior at Case Western Reserve University, **Andrew Smeader** is majoring in music and finance through the Joint Music Program with the Cleveland Institute of Music and Case Western's Weatherhead School of Management while splitting time as an integrated master's student in finance. In 2018, Andrew was selected to perform with fellow CAPS and Cleveland Orchestra musicians live on a national broadcast of the TODAY show in celebration of the Cleveland Orchestra's 100th Anniversary. He has also served as Concertmaster and Principal Second of the University Circle Symphony Orchestra,

and in 2020 served as Concertmaster of The Lakeland Civic Orchestra. Andrew regularly performs with The Mansfield Symphony, The Cleveland Philharmonic Orchestra, and recently with The Cleveland Pops Orchestra at Severance Hall and with Andrea Bocelli. At Case Western, Andrew was awarded the Wilma Anne Trenkamp Music Scholarship and served as President and Performance Chair of the Mu Phi Epsilon-Omicron chapter. He was also named by the International Mu Phi Epsilon Foundation a 2020 winner of the Beth Landis Violin Scholarship and Gerke Collegiate Artist Scholarship. Andrew currently studies with Dr. Stephen Sims at The Cleveland Institute of Music, takes sonata studies with Carolyn Warner, baroque violin with Julie Andrijeski, piano with Derek Nishimura, and additional violin studies with Yoko Moore. In his free time, Andrew loves to play chamber music, hike, cook, bake, enjoy the autumn weather, fantasize about getting a shiba inu, and gain inspiration from his favorite violin soloist, Sayaka Shoji.
