About the Soloist

Rebecca “Becky” Schneirov is a fourth-year student pursuing a B.A. in Economics and Statistics at Case Western Reserve University (CWRU). She has played clarinet in a variety of ensembles and clubs at CWRU, including Symphonic Winds, Klezmer Ensemble, Case/University Circle Symphony Orchestra, Camerata Chamber Orchestra, and various other chamber groups. She was also a member of the Spartan Marching Band and CWRU Pep Band playing clarinet and alto saxophone. When she’s not making music, Becky serves as president of the Weatherhead Economics Society, works as a Resident Assistant for the Upper Class Experience, participates in research with Dr. Daniel Shoag (CWRU), and serves as a teaching assistant for several courses. She also serves as the Vice President of Finance for the CWRU Chamber Collective (CCC).

About the Conductors

Jacob Shaw is an arranger, composer, and multi-instrumentalist, currently pursuing a Masters degree in Engineering and Management at Case Western Reserve University. His arrangements and compositions have been primarily for wind and marching bands, with some explorations into smaller ensembles. Some of his works have been performed at Case Western Reserve University (CWRU) and various other music institutions. Jacob has experience working with high school and college musicians. Most recently, he formed the CWRU Clarinet Choir in February 2022 and the CWRU Brass Ensemble in August 2022 and currently serves as the music director for both.

Emma Bentley is a second-year student pursuing a B.S. degree in Music Education at Case Western Reserve University (CWRU). In 2019, Emma created the Victor Winds Project at Victor Senior High School and served as its conductor and musical director until graduating in 2021. At CWRU, Emma serves as president of the CWRU Chamber Collective (CCC), president of the Music Undergraduate Student Involvement Committee (MUSIC), and treasurer for the CWRU chapter of the Ohio Collegiate Music Education Association (OCMEA). She currently plays clarinet in the Case/University Circle Symphony Orchestra and is an active member of the Percussion Ensemble, Chamber Ensembles, CWRU Footlighters pit orchestra, CWRU Brass Ensemble, and the Spartan Marching Band. In January 2022, Emma decided to expand the music scene at CWRU, founding the Woodwind 9tet ensemble. She is also the assistant conductor for the CWRU Clarinet Choir.

Georgia Martinez is a third-year student pursuing a B.S. in Computer Science at Case Western Reserve University (CWRU). She plays the euphonium in Symphonic Winds and the trombone in the Spartan Marching Band. Her arrangements have been performed by various chamber groups and the Highland Park High School pit orchestra spanning four different musical productions. Outside of music, she is a teaching assistant for software craftsmanship, a research assistant in the INVent lab, a programmer on the CWRUbotix MATE ROV team, and a tour guide. She also serves as the Vice President of Administration and Risk for the CWRU Chamber Collective (CCC).

Ian Wenz is a flutist and educator based in Cleveland, Ohio. He is on faculty at the Hudson and Fairlawn Schools of Music and is the flute instructor for Lakewood City Schools. He also serves as a woodwind coach for the Contemporary Youth Orchestra. Ian performs regularly with various ensembles throughout Northeast Ohio, including a most recent performance as a concerto soloist with the Cleveland Repertory Orchestra. He holds a Master of Music Degree in Performance from the University of Akron and a Bachelor of Music in Performance from Bowling Green State University. His primary teachers include Katherine DeJongh, Nina Assimakopoulos and George Pope for which he is incredibly grateful.

About the Ensembles

The **CWRU Chamber Collective** was started to provide the Case Western Reserve University community with the chance to make music in a fully student-led environment. Wind 9tet was started by Emma Bentley in January 2022 as a non-traditional wind consort, composed of flute, oboe, clarinet, euphonium, and bassoon; it's not quite the standard wind group! Jacob Shaw created the CWRU Clarinet Choir in February 2022 to give an opportunity to perform in an ensemble with other dedicated clarinetists. Most recently, the CWRU Brass Ensemble was formed in May 2022 to give community members the chance to make music in an all-brass setting.
