

## MUEN 358 - Fall 2023 String and Strings with Piano Chamber Music

### **Instructor Information:**

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## **Course Description:**

The string and string/piano chamber music experience at the Case Western Reserve University has been developed with the following goals in mind:

- 1) to provide insight into, and in-depth knowledge of, the chamber music repertoire
- 2) to develop chamber music performance practice at the highest artistic level
- 3) to develop a balance of cognitive and emotional intelligence in relating to the music and to other members of the ensemble
- 4) to develop leadership skills essential to working in a small ensemble and orchestra setting
- 5) to prepare ensembles for a culminating performance

### **Course Registration and Assignments:**

- Enrollment in this course is by audition only. Case students are not required to be music majors to audition. Auditions take place in the context of orchestra auditions during Week 1 of the fall semester. Mid-year students may join the course by auditioning for a faculty member.
- This course requires at least two semesters of concurrent enrollment in Orchestra (MUEN 385).
- All Case students wishing to participate in MUEN 358 must register for this course. Permission needs to be requested through the CIM Registrar, Hallie Moore (<a href="mailto:hallie.moore@cim.edu">hallie.moore@cim.edu</a>) before the CIM drop/add deadline at the end of Week 2.
- The course may be taken for 1 credit or for 0 credits.
- Groups will be formed and coaches assigned by the end of Week 1.



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### **Course Guidelines and Requirements:**

- Consult coach/coordinator to determine repertoire to be studied and performed. Piano chamber music groups must have approval of pianist's major instructor in advance.
- Consult with group members to schedule weekly rehearsal times, to commence in Week 1 or 2.
- Schedule regular coaching sessions, to commence in Week 3 or 4.
- Participate in full class master class Saturday, October 7, 4-6pm in Harkness Chapel
- Perform in final chamber music recital at end of semester.
- Attendance of entire concert is mandatory.
