A specialist in merengue and salsa, Jackie also has worked on recordings by the Jazz Heritage Orchestra and by Impacto Nuevo, the area's leading Latin band.

Senior Instructor PAUL FERGUSON is Artistic Director of the Cleveland Jazz Orchestra and Principal Trombonist and Arranger for the Cleveland Pops. A veteran of the Glenn Miller and Tommy Dorsey Orchestras, he graduated from the Eastman School and has taught at CWRU since 1988.
