Chris Anderson is one of today's leading jazz trombonists and educators. A native of Shaker Heights, Ohio, he performs regularly with the Cleveland Jazz Orchestra and other regional ensembles and serves on the faculty of the Oberlin Conservatory. He is also the founder of Open Tone Music, a nonprofit organization dedicated to expanding access to high-quality music education and performance opportunities throughout Northeast Ohio.

Paul Ferguson has taught at Case since 1988. He is Artistic Director of the Cleveland Jazz Orchestra and Principal Trombone and Arranger for the Cleveland Pops.
