




PDX Survey

Most Requested Histologies



Big leap discovery

- IO and Cell therapy improving targets and efficacy
- Metastasis microenvironment, heterogeneity and EMT
- Pursuit of poorly responding tumor subpopulations
 - Genomic, epigenomic, clonal evolution, Rx resistance

 - Pancreatic cancer Jordan Winter, MD
