

## Notes:

- 1. Cancers are included if the rate is among the top 20, and the absolute rate difference between catchment area and U.S. is at least 5%.
- 2. Catchment Area include 15 counties in Northeast Ohio: Ashland, Ashtabula, Cuyahoga, Erie, Geauga, Huron, Lake, Lorain, Mahoning, Medina, Portage, Stark, Summit, Trumbull, and Wayne Counties.
- 3. Excessive cases (per year) is estimated by multiply the population of the catchment area by the difference in mortality rates between the catchment area and the US.
- \* Rates for breast, cervical, ovary, and uterus cancers are limited to females; Rates for testis and prostate cancers are limited to males.
