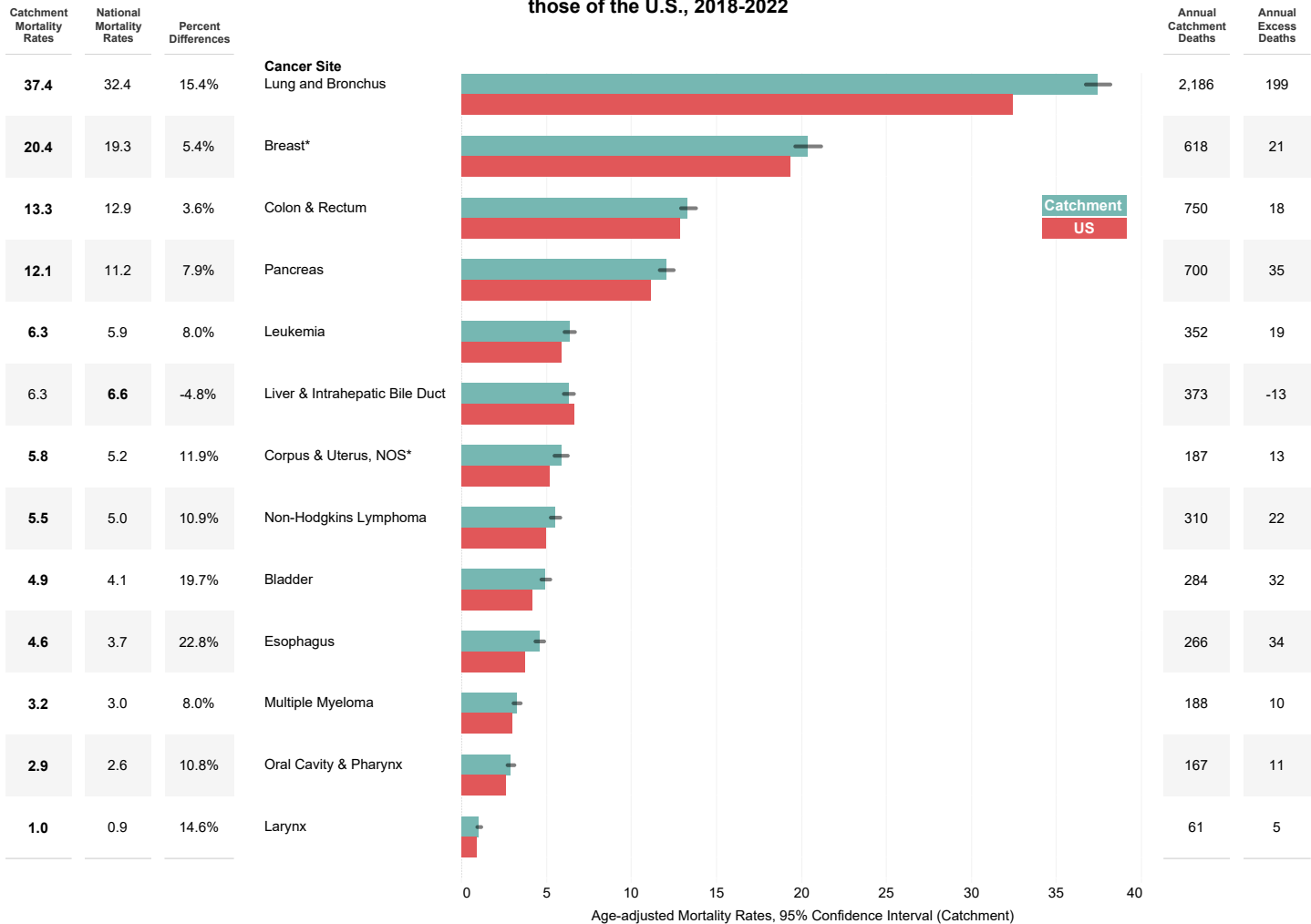


Cancer Types in the Catchment Area with Mortality Rates Statistically Differing from those of the U.S., 2018-2022



Notes:

1. Confidence intervals are displayed only for catchment rates. U.S. rates reflect population-level estimates.
 2. Mortality rates are expressed as age-adjusted cases per 100,000 population.
 3. Excess cases (per year) are estimated by multiplying the population of the catchment area by the difference in mortality rates between the catchment area and the US.
 4. The catchment area includes 15 counties in Northeast Ohio: Ashland, Ashtabula, Cuyahoga, Erie, Geauga, Huron, Lake, Lorain, Mahoning, Medina, Portage, Stark, Summit, Trumbull, and Wayne Counties.
- * Rates for breast and uterine cancers are based on the female population.
