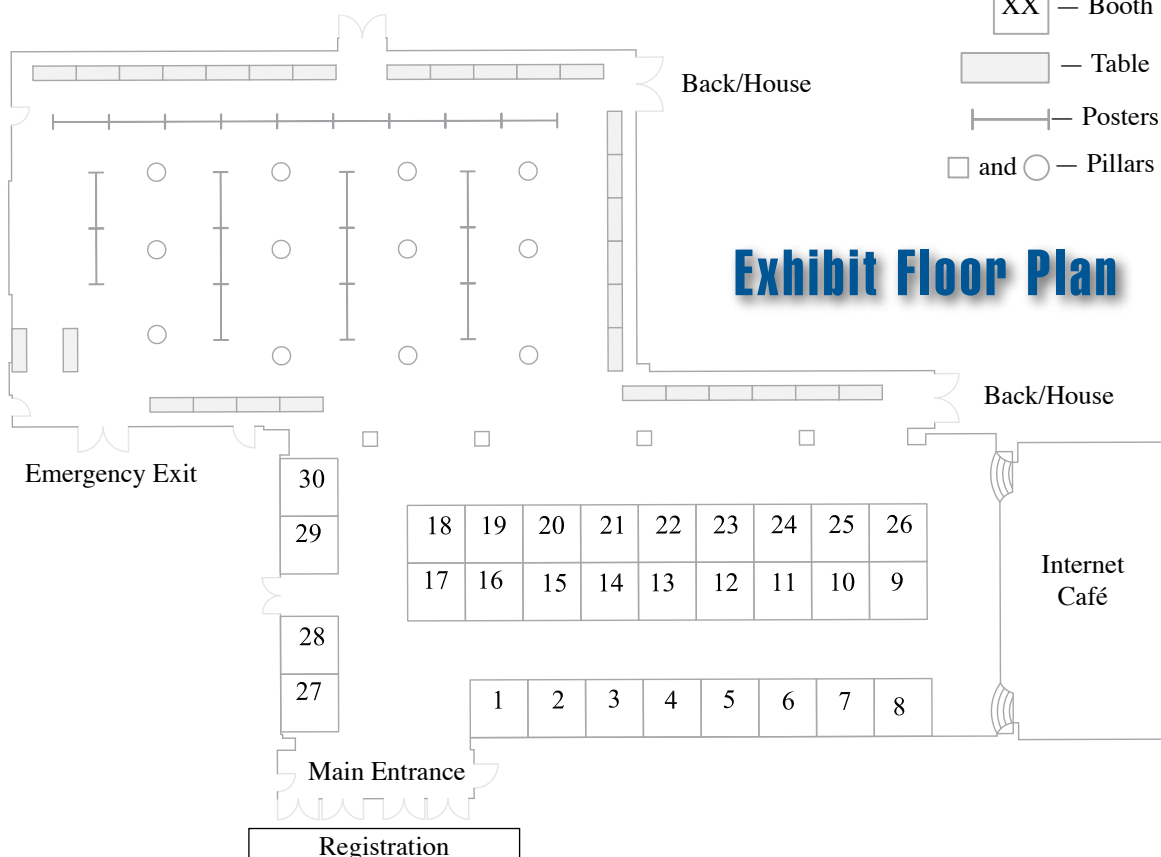
Exhibiting at CERMACS 2009
