

Materials/Equipment for surgeon and assistant:

- Presurgical scrubbing
- Protective equipment

Materials/Equipment For patients:

- Surgical gowns (drapes)
- Surgical head dress
- Surgical toweling
- Towelettes (gauze)
- Mouth rinse (Peridex, Listerine)
- Protective eyewear



Appropriate equipment does not permit blood or other potentially infectious materials to pass through to the employee's clothing, skin, eyes, or mouth during normal use



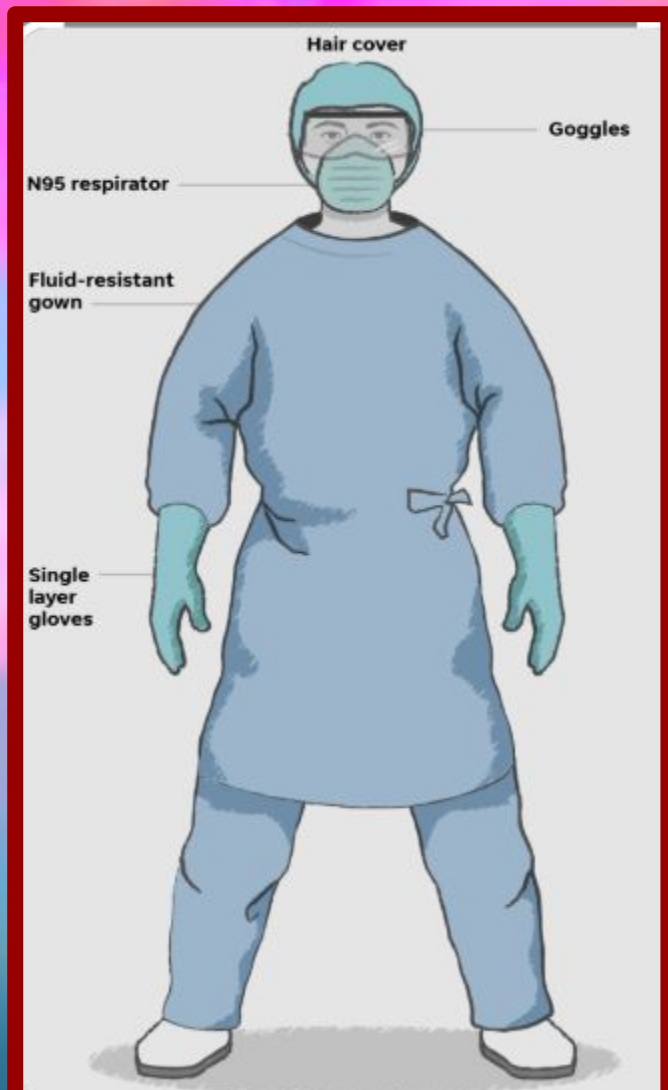
use 1.2% hydrogen peroxide rinse before and during the procedure



Because bacteria tend to flourish under rubber gloves, the hands should be scrubbed diligently prior to putting on surgical gloves.



Eyes should be protected for patient, surgeon, and assistants by specially designed eyewear

- Masks
- Caps
- Eyewear
- Gloves
