

## Application for Fall 2018

## Eligibility

To enroll in the Fall 2018 EMT Class, you must:

- 1. Be affiliated with CWRU.
- 2. Agree to serve at least **60 HOURS** with CWRU EMS.
- 3. Submit your application by August 23rd, 2018. Late applications will not be considered.
- 4. Complete an interview with the CWRU EMS Selection Committee on August 25, 2018 or August 26, 2018.
- 5. Be available for class on Mondays and Wednesdays from 6pm-10pm, and select Saturday labs from 8:00 am-12:00 pm. 100% attendance is required.

#### Selection Criteria

The Selection Committee will consider:

- 1. Your application
- 2. Your interview
- 3. Optional (email directly to cwruems-application@case.edu):
  - a. Personal Resume
  - b. Letter of Recommendation from a teacher/work supervisor

#### **Notification**

- 1. You will be notified of your admission decision on August 26, 2018 by 11:59 pm.
  - a. The CWRU EMS Selection Committee reserves the right to deny enrollment into the CWRU EMS course.
- 2. You must accept your offer by August 28th at 11:59pm.
- 3. There will be a mandatory orientation session from 8:00 -10:00 pm on August 29th.

## Scholarship

Scholarships are available for applicants who express financial need. In addition to the EMT class application form, individuals applying for a scholarship must:


- 1. State their financial need in the application.
