

Application for CWRU EMS Spring 2019 EMT Course

Eligibility

To enroll in the Spring 2019 EMT Class, you must:

- 1. Be affiliated with CWRU.
- 2. Agree to serve at least **60 HOURS** with CWRU EMS during Spring and Fall 2019.
- 3. Submit your application by November 8, 2018. Late applications will not be considered.
- 4. If selected for an interview spot, complete an interview with the CWRU EMS Interview Committee on November 17, 2018 or November 18, 2018.
- 5. Be available for class on Mondays and Wednesdays during the Spring 2019 semester from 6pm-10pm, and select Saturday labs from 8:00 am-12:00 pm. 100% attendance is required.
- 6. Be aware of the \$750 class cost.

Selection Criteria

- 1. Your application
- 2. Your interview
- 3. Optional (email directly to cwruems-application@case.edu):
 - a. Personal Resume
 - b. Letter of Recommendation from a teacher/work supervisor

Notification

- 1. You will be notified of your interview decision on November 11, 2018 by 11:59 pm. You will be notified of your admission decision on November 18, 2018 by 11:59 pm.
 - a. The CWRU EMS Selection Committee reserves the right to deny any applicant an interview and/or enrollment into the CWRU EMS course.
- 2. You must accept your offer by November 25, 2018 at 11:59pm.
- 3. There will be a mandatory orientation session from 8:00 10:00 pm on December 1, 2018.

Scholarship

Scholarships are available for applicants who express financial need (class cost \$750). In addition to the EMT class application form, individuals applying for a scholarship must:

- 1. State their financial need in the application.
- 2. Advise the Selection Committee of their current employment and average hours worked per week.
- 3. Complete the CWRU EMS Scholarship Application Essay
