Eligibility

- 1. Be a student, faculty, or university staff member at CWRU. Note that preference will be given to current undergraduate students.
- 2. Submit your application as a pdf to cwruems-application@case.edu by January 13, 2020 at 11:59 pm. Late applications will **not** be considered.
- 3. If selected for an interview spot, complete an interview with the CWRU EMS Interview Committee on January 15th, 2020 between 6:00 pm and 10:00 pm. Interview times will be assigned.
- 4. Be available for a mandatory orientation on January 17th at 8:00 pm. There may be further mandatory certifications.

Selection Criteria

 - b. Letter of Recommendation

Notification

- 1. You will be notified of your interview decision by email on January 14, 2020.
- 2. If you are selected for an interview, confirm your interview appointment by email by 10:00 am on January 15, 2020.
- 3. If you are selected to join the organization, confirm your enrollment by email by 3:00 pm on January 17, 2020.
- 4. After confirming your enrollment, you must attend a <u>mandatory</u> orientation session from 8:00 pm 10:00 pm on January 17, 2020.
