# Eligibility

To enroll in the Spring 2021 EMT Class, you must:

- 1. Be a current CWRU undergraduate student.
- 2. Submit your application by January 8th, 2021 at 11:59 pm EST. Late applications will not be considered.
- 3. If selected for an interview spot, complete an interview with the CWRU EMS Interview Committee on January 16th, 2021 or January 17th, 2021. Interview times will be assigned.
- 4. Be available for class on Mondays and Wednesdays during the Spring 2021 semester from 6:00 pm-10:00 pm, and Saturday labs from 8:00 am-12:00 pm.
- 5. Be aware of the \$750 class cost and approximately \$200 in additional costs (uniform, certifications, etc.). Financial aid is available by application.
