## **Of Particular Importance to** *All* **University Faculty**

#### **Resolution on Recent Executive Order on Immigration**

The Faculty Senate endorsed a resolution opposing the recent Executive Order on immigration. The resolution was sponsored by elected senators and Senate standing committee chairs with appointments in the College. The Senate directed the Chair of the Faculty Senate and the Secretary of the University Faculty to transmit copies of the resolution to both Senators from Ohio and to all members of the Ohio congressional delegation, asking them to act swiftly to reverse the Executive Order through legislative action. The Senate further directed them to disseminate the resolution to the media.

#### <u>The Faculty Senate approved the following policies from the Faculty Senate Committee on</u> <u>Undergraduate Education:</u>

- Beginning in the fall of 2017, students who withdraw after the 11<sup>th</sup> Friday of a semester may not enroll for the next two academic sessions, including the summer session. Exceptions may be granted by the Academic Standing Board.
- 2. Beginning in the fall of 2017, students placed or continuing on probation are required to review their course schedules with their deans in the Office of Undergraduate Studies before the end of the drop/add period in order to continue for the semester.
- 3. Beginning in the fall of 2017, academic probation will be a status recorded on the unofficial/advising transcript but not on the official transcript.

#### <u>Amendment to Faculty Handbook Regarding Chair of the Emeriti Academy as Non-</u> Voting Member of the Senate
