PARKING & TRANSPORTATION PLAN FOR THE HEALTH EDUCATION CAMPUS Updated –January 14, 2019

Parking Permit Assignments

- Up to a total of 500 parking spaces have been allocated within the JJ garage adjacent to the HEC facility for CWRU faculty and staff. These spaces are not segregated and will be available on a first-come-first –serve basis. In addition, faculty & staff can choose to park in the West Campus parking facility (CWRU owned) located a short distance from the HEC.
- Last Spring, a survey was sent to all current Health Sciences' faculty & staff permit holders that will be relocated to the HEC requesting their parking preference. 235 indicated they would select the JJ garage and 41 indicated West Campus.
- All students will be assigned to the West Campus facility. Currently, there are <u>433</u> Health Sciences' students who have parking permits on main campus
- The 2018/19 monthly rate for the JJ garage is \$90.00 per/month plus a one-time, \$25.00 hang tag fee. The rate for the West Campus is \$61.99 per month.
- All permit assignments, issuance and payment processes will be handled through CWRU Access Services. Permit selection and issuance will begin in March of 19'
- HEC permit holders with valid work related requirements to park at the CWRU main campus will be able to obtain courtesy passes through Access Services for the Veale or HSC garages. CWRU main campus permit holders with valid work related requirements to park near HEC can obtain courtesy passes for the West Campus parking lots
- Preceptors, volunteers, visiting faculty and other groups will be able to park in JJ and utilize the validation process which involves the use of vouchers issued by Access Services and charged back to end user departments
- In the rare event of an overflow parking situation in JJ garage, CWRU permit holders will be able to use the West Campus parking facility or designated Cleveland Clinic overflow parking lots

Visitor Parking

- Visitors and guests coming to the HEC will be able to utilize the JJ garage
- Visitor parking payment validation will be available for use by HEC departments. This process will be coordinated through CWRU Access Services. Validation procedures will be issued to all departments prior to building occupancy
- The new Dental Clinic lot on Chester Ave. will be restricted for the exclusive use of Dental Clinic patients. Access to this lot will be controlled through an automated gate arm system
- Special Event parking plans will be coordinated between CWRU event sponsors, CWRU Access Services and Cleveland Clinic Parking representatives

Transportation Services

- Several new shuttle routes will be implemented to support HEC transportation needs as follow (see attached route map for additional information):
 - Main Route CWRU Campus to HEC (multiple stops)
 - Nursing Route Shuttles serving Nursing students' specific class schedule for transport between CWRU main campus and HEC
 - HSC Flyer Route Direct service from CWRU Health Sciences campus to HEC
 - West Campus shuttle- Transporting parkers to HEC campus from the WC parking facilty
 - Off hour, "on demand" shuttle service
- On demand shuttle service is responsive transit dedicated to HEC commuters to and from main campus. It will be in service nightly from 9pm to 6am
- Standard Parking will operate the majority of the new shuttle routes within the scope of the existing joint parking and transportation program
- The West Campus parking lot shuttle service will be provided via a shared-services program with Cleveland Clinic through expansion of their existing West Campus shuttle service
- The new shuttle busses required to support the expanded HEC program have been ordered through Standard Parking in order to have them available prior to the HEC occupancy date

Additional Information Regarding Parking & Transportation

- Initial shuttle route deployment is based on projected demand and specific requests from the schools. It is anticipated that routes will be adjusted as actual ridership patterns emerge. Proposed adjustments to the routes will be reviewed with representatives from the schools prior to any changes
- Shuttles will be equipped with the TransLoc real time tracking system and the Passio automated rider counting system
- New bus stop signs will be added at each newly designated HEC bus stop
- An agreement has been executed with Lyft which will be available to address additional transportation needs that may be identified
