**ANIMALS RUNNING AT LARGE
VILLAGE OF HUNTING VALLEY ORDINANCE**

As cited in The CITY ORDINANCE, Chapter 505.01 and 505.99 *NO PERSON SHALL PERMIT THEIR ANIMAL TO RUN AT LARGE UPON ANY PUBLIC WAY OR UPON UNENCLOSED LAND (505.01) (ORC 951.02). THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF ANY ANIMAL IN OR UPON ANY OF THE PLACES MENTIONED IS EVIDENCE THAT THE OFFENDER(S) IS IN VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION AND WILL BE SUBJECT TO PENALTY (505.99) (ORC 951.02;Ord. 1993-109)*

The University Farm Administration requires that above ordinance be followed by keeping animals leashed at all times while on Farm property. Electric collars are not permitted as an appropriate leash. Dog walkers are limited to no more than 2 dogs per person while on Farm property. Leash signs are posted in several areas on property. Hunting Valley police and Farm staff will enforce above Ordinance without exception.

We are often unaware of the problems dogs cause. Dogs run into the ponds where research and teaching is going on. Research and teaching materials have been damaged and students' time is often lost as a consequence. Some people are afraid of dogs running loose. We have had incidents of people being bitten by "friendly" and "playful" dogs.

The Farm is a multiuse facility open to many people for diverse purposes. We must respect the researcher, student, picnicker, and casual visitor. **Violators will be asked to leave the property and could be subject to possible fines if in violation of above ordinance.**
