# A guide to the Common Grassland Plants of University Farm

### Important notes on this guide

- \* This is an introductory guide to the common grassland plant species of University farm.
- \* It lists the species most commonly present in research fields 8 and 9, and attempts to provide baseline information that will be useful to anyone wishing to learn more about the grassland plants found here.
- \* Note that several members of the Family Poaceae may occur in Field 8, though the species present have not been identified.
- Make sure you have a good field guide in hand before setting off to discover the grassland plants of the farm!

# Polytrichum commune Haircap Moss

- Class Bryopsida
  - \* Order Polytrichales
    - \* Family Polytrichaceae
- Leaves: lanceolate; to 1 cm long
- Sporophytes: long, wiry, upright stalk with horizontal capsules
- Height: to 15 cm tall

### Juncus tenuis Path Rush

- Class Liliopsida
  - \* Order Poales
    - \* Family Juncaceae
- \* Leaves: grasslike; evergreen; sheath around stem; occur in a basal tuft
- Seed Head: brown; dense corymb at top of stem
- Height: to 3m





# Carex vulpinoidea Fox Sedge

- \* Class Liliopsida
  - \* Order Poales
    - \* Family Cyperaceae
- \* Leaves: long; narrow; form a closed sheath around the stem; 3-ranked (come off of stem at 3 different angles)
- Seed Head: arranged in spikes of alternating clusters
- \* Stem: triangular; solid

# Andropogon virginicus Broomsedge bluestem

- \* Class Liliopsida
  - \* Order Poales
    - \* Family Poaceae
- \* Leaves: long and thin; form an unclosed sheath around the stem; 2-ranked (come off of stem at 2 different angles)
- \* Seed Head: 3 projections
- Stem: blue/purple circular; hollow at internodes



### Setaria glauca Yellow Foxtail Grass

- \* Class Liliopsida
  - \* Order Poales
    - \* Family Poaceae
- \* Leaves: long and very thin; form an unclosed sheath around the stem; 2-ranked
- \* Seed Head: dense, hairy panicle
- Stem: circular; hollow at internodes

### Panicum dichotomiflorum Field 9 Fall Panicgrass

- \* Class Liliopsida
  - \* Order Poales
    - \* Family Poaceae
- \* Leaves: long and thin; prominent midrib; form an unclosed sheath around the stem; 2-ranked
- Flowers: broad panicle
- Stem: circular; hollow at internodes

### Digitaria sanguinalis Common Crabgrass

- Class Liliopsida
  - \* Order Poales
    - \* Family Poaceae
- \* Leaves: long and thin; form an unclosed sheath around the stem; 2-ranked
- Flowers: long; finger-like
- Stem: circular; hollow at internodes

# Leersia oryzoides Rice Cutgrass

- Class Liliopsida
  - \* Order Poales
    - \* Family Poaceae
- \* Leaves: long and thin; form an unclosed sheath around the stem; 2-ranked; abrasive
- Flowers: open panicle
- Stem: circular; hollow at internodes

### Phleum pratense Common Timothy

- \* Class Liliopsida
  - \* Order Poales
    - \* Family Poaceae
- \* Leaves: long and thin; form an unclosed sheath around the stem; 2-ranked
- Flowers: tight, solitary, narrow apical spikes
- Stem: circular; hollow at internodes

### Agrostis alba Redtop Bent

- Class Liliopsida
  - \* Order Poales
    - \* Family Poaceae
- \* Leaves: long and thin; form an unclosed sheath around the stem; 2-ranked; distinct veins
- Flowers: pyramidal panicle
- Stem: circular; hollow at internodes

### Holcus lanatus Velvet Grass

- Class Liliopsida
  - \* Order Poales
    - \* Family Poaceae
- \* Leaves: long and thin; form an unclosed sheath around the stem; 2-ranked; have a "soft" appearance
- Flowers: dense, feathery clusters
- Stem: circular; hollow at internodes

# Dactylis glomerata Orchardgrass

- \* Class Liliopsida
  - \* Order Poales
    - \* Family Poaceae
- \* Leaves: long and relatively broad for a grass; form an unclosed sheath around the stem; 2-ranked
- Flowers: tufted panicle
- Stem: circular; hollow at internodes



### Bromus inermis Smooth Bromegrass

- \* Class Liliopsida
  - \* Order Poales
    - \* Family Poaceae
- \* Leaves: long and thin; form an unclosed sheath around the stem; 2-ranked
- Flowers: loose, nodding panicle
- Stem: circular; hollow at internodes
