	(2) Student will assume technical and/or supervisory responsibility.
	(3) These positions suggest advanced technical skills and are normally reserved for students
	who are capable of functioning in a supervisory capacity.

	(1) Required skills and experience with two to three years of related job experience or preparation.
	(2) Positions that demand highly technical skills and/or maturity associated with supervisory
