

Scholarships & Grants

- Difference between scholarships and grants
 - Merit vs. Need-based
- Scholarship Retention Criteria
 - Good academic standing



Student Employment

- Federal Work-Study: need-based
 - Student wages are subsidized by the federal government up to the student's earnings limit
 - Earnings are excluded from upcoming year student contribution
- Campus Employment: non-need based
 - Almost two thirds of all student employment positions do not require Federal Work-Study

Working is optional but all income is taxable.



Basic Pay Information

- Campus minimum wage is \$9.20 per hour
- Students are paid twice per month
 - The 15th and the last business day of the month
 - Direct deposit can be set up in HCM system
- Maximum hours a student can work per week = 20
 - Average is 8 to 10 hours per week
- May work up to 40 hours per week during long breaks (i.e. winter, spring and summer breaks)



Federal Direct Student Loans

- Repayment begins after 6-month grace period
- Base annual loan limits (combined subsidized and unsubsidized) with a fixed interest rate of 2.75%:
 - \$5,500 for 1st year undergraduates with no more than \$3,500 Subsidized
 - \$6,500 for 2nd year undergraduates with no more than \$4,500 Subsidized
 - \$7,500 for each remaining undergraduate year with no more than \$5,500 Subsidized



Federal Direct Parent Loan for Undergraduate Students (PLUS)

- Annual loan limit: cost of attendance minus any other aid
- Unsubsidized Fixed interest rate of 5.30%
 - Loan origination fee of 4.236%
 - If not approved, student is eligible for additional Direct Unsubsidized Loan
- Repayment, *upon request*, can be deferred until after the student graduates or drops below half-time



Federal Direct Loan Requirements

- Master Promissory Note (MPN)
 - Student promissory note is generally valid for 10 years
 - Agreeing to take out the loan and pay it back
- Entrance Counseling
 - Know your rights and responsibilities
- PLUS Application



Managing Your Loans

- Make sure students are actually completing their documents
- My Financial Aid shows funds that are accepted
- SIS shows funds that have been paid to account
- Federal loans will be listed at


Moving Forward


Student Privacy/FERPA

- Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA)
 - Students' Rights to Privacy
 - May not release information, including finances, unless prior written consent from the student
- "Authorized User" See SIS Finances User Guide at https://case.edu/studentaccounts/your-student-account/authorizing-user
 - Inquire on student's account
 - Receive billing notifications
 - Pay student's bill electronically
 - View account activity

Billing

- Online (paperless)
- Quikpay online billing and payment processing system
- Monthly email notification about availability of e-bill
 - Sent to: students, "authorized users" and 2nd e-mail address if provided
- E-mail notification only if there is <u>a balance due</u> <u>including pending financial aid, if any.</u>



Statements

- Billing Statement
 - Activities since the last billing statement
 - As of billing date
- Statement of Account
 - Activities are summarized by term
 - Real-time

Payment Plans

Enrollment available in SIS, monthly automatic withdrawals on the 10th of the month

► 4-PAY or 3-PAY Payment Plans

Budgeting tool, prepayments towards semester's charges

- Spring 2021: October 2020 through January 2021
- Fall 2021: June 2021 through September 2021

➤2-PAY Extended Plan

- 2 equal monthly automatic withdrawals past the due date
 - Fall 2020: October 2020 and November 2020
 - Spring 2021: February 2020 and March 2020
- Enrollment fee 2.7% of the outstanding balance



Payment Methods

- Domestic payments:
 - Quikpay through SIS
 - E-checks (no service charge)
 - Debit or credit cards (2.7% of transaction amount charged at the time of transaction by bill processor non-refundable)
 - With Payment Coupon/Remittance Slip, mail checks, money orders, bank checks to:

Payment Methods, cont'd

- Domestic payments (continued):
 - Hand-deliver cash, checks, money orders, bank checks to Cashier's Office in Yost Hall Room 165
 - Other (e.g., 529/College Savings Plans)
- International payments
 - Flywire through SIS (preferred)
 - Other direct bank-to-bank wire transfer (permitted)

Others

- Unpaid Balances
 - Late fees at 1.5% of unpaid balance monthly
 - Right to withhold certain services
 - Registration hold for upcoming semester
 - Inability to access transcripts
 - Delayed receipt of diploma
- Tax year 1098-T Form
 - Online access in SIS by student (mid-January)
 - All others, mailed by January 31st
- Tuition Refund Insurance
 - Reimburse educational expenses for term withdrawal due to illness, injury or a psychological condition
 - Optional and not automatic



Key Takeaways

- "Authorized User"
- Include student ID and name on all correspondence
- Waive health plan if have comparable coverage
- Review invoice / billing statement
- Payment in full by September 4th for Fall 2020
