The open enrollment period for Benelect, the university's health insurance program, begins **Monday, November 9** and concludes **Monday, November 30**.

This fall Benelect participants have an opportunity again to earn incentives in 2021 by completing a health risk appraisal and two of three additional activities: biometric screening; primary care provider attestation form; and/or tobacco attestation form. This program is part of the university's ongoing effort to improve the health of our population. The university will offer additional wellness programs in 2021, including classes focused on tobacco cessation, stress management, weight management or nutrition, physical activity and financial and community well-being.
