The Inamori Ethics Prize

Case Western Reserve University and the Inamori International Center for Ethics and Excellence present the Inamori Ethics Prize to individuals who have demonstrated exemplary ethical leadership through actions that have greatly improved the condition of humankind.

The Inamori Ethics Prize recognizes and honors individuals who provide an example of ethical leadership on an international scale or have made significant and lasting contributions to the global understanding of ethics. The prize exists to educate the public about pressing ethical issues of our time and to teach students of all ages how to make a positive and lasting change in the world.

The Nominee

The nominee should be a person who has either shown or taught others what true ethical leadership is in any field of endeavor. The nominee's example should inspire others to take action and respect the dignity and worth of all human beings. Their efforts must be done in the spirit of service to humankind, be unquestionably beneficial, have international aspects and/or a global reach, and be likely to endure. The nominee must be alive and able to travel to Cleveland, Ohio in the United States of America for the prize events.

The Celebration

The Inamori Ethics Prize provides a monetary award of \$35,000, intended to support the recipient's ongoing work. Each year's winner is conferred the prize at Case Western Reserve University where they deliver a public lecture and participate in a symposium and other campus events.
