The annual undergraduate retention tables are prepared by the Office of Planning and Institutional Research using the Registrar's fall enrollment census. For the purpose of these tables, students are said to be retained if they are enrolled in the subsequent fall semester as of the census date, which is the end of the third week of classes. All cohort totals have been adjusted to reflect federal exclusions or retroactive changes in status.

Students in the Six-Year Dental Program, Integrated Graduate Studies, or other integrated undergraduate/graduate program are considered retained (if enrolled) until they are awarded either the bachelor's or DMD degrees within six years, even though they are not enrolled as undergraduates.

Transfer tables now include spring transfer students. These students were included in the cohort for the fall immediately preceding their enrollment term.
