In 2022, we placed third in the United States and 14th in the world in the Jessup International Law Moot Court Competition, and won the best speaker in the world award. Our Vis International Arbitration Moot Court Team made it to the elimination rounds and captured a best speaker award. And in 2021, we placed second in the International Criminal Court Moot Court Competition for North and South America and advanced to the guarterfinals of the world championship rounds.
