


# Prague: The Jewel of Eastern Europe

## **Prague Program Highlights**

- Welcome dinner evening of arrival;
- Walking tour of Prague around Wenceslas Square and the Old Town with its famous Astronomical Clock atop the 14th-century Town Hall. We'll continue through the Jewish Ghetto to St. Nicholas Church and stroll along the banks of the Vltava River to the Charles Bridge;
- Excursion into the beautiful Czech countryside today to Karlovy Vary, a magnificent old spa town beloved by the European nobility. Walking tour and a visit to Moser Glassworks, established in 1857:
- Visit Terezín, an 18th-century Austrian fortress, which later became a World War II transit camp for Jewish people, many of whom were later transported to Auschwitz Tour;
- Explore Dresden where we'll see the recently restored Frauenkirche and visit the New Green Vault Museum;
- Visit the 17th-century Konopištê Castle, the last residence of Archduke Franz Ferdinand of Austria, heir to the Austro-Hungarian throne, whose assassination in Sarajevo triggered World War I;
- Explore Prague with a tour of the Lobkowicz Palace, a part of the Prague Castle complex housing the Lobkowicz collections of paintings, ceramics, arms and armor and original musical scores and enjoy a lunchtime concert;
- Dinner cruise along the Vltava River this evening
