- **SEE** herds of bison and elk and look for longhorn sheep, Bald Eagles, badgers, deer, wolves, and coyotes in Lamar Valley, America's Serengeti.
- **VISIT** the Grizzly and Wolf Discovery Center, an educational wildlife park dedicated to conservation of the area's wild animals.
- **WITNESS** the geysers, hot springs, and fumaroles of Yellowstone's Lower Geyser Basin, Fountain Paint Pots, and iconic Old Faithful.
- **HIKE TRAILS** and search for wildlife around Tenon's Jenny Lake and the forests around West Yellowstone.
- **LEARN HOW** the Bear River Refuge provides critical habitat for migrating birds including the American White Pelican, Snowy Plover, Black-neck Stilt, Cinnamon Teal. and Tundra Swan.
