Program Highlights







Long Walk To Freedom

Step back in time to pivotal moments in South Africa's anti-apartheid movement and Nelson Mandela's autobiography, Long Walk to Freedom. Inspiring visits and illuminating discussions reveal the historic 20th-century milestones that culminated in the momentous inauguration of South Africa's first Black president—laying the foundation for progressive economic, social, and political prosperity. Follow in Mandela's footsteps through Soweto, visiting his former home on renowned Vilakazi Street, and explore UNESCO World Heritage-designated Robben Island, the isolated former outpost for political prisoners off the coast of Cape Town. Stand before the Union Buildings in Pretoria, where Mandela was inaugurated in 1994 after South Africa held the first multiracial democratic general election in its history. On April 27, 1995, the first commemoration of Freedom Day—a public holiday celebrating the anniversary of that historic moment—Mandela addressed the people of South Africa with considerable optimism about the "past from which we come as a nation; the great possibilities that we now have; and the bright future that beckons us." Mandela's legacy as an activist, leader, and great humanitarian still resonates today.









DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

U.S./Johannesburg, South Africa Day 1 and Day 2

Depart the U.S. and arrive the next day in cosmopolitan Johannesburg, known colloquially as "Joburg," and check into the five-star FAIRLAWNS BOUTIOUE HOTEL & SPA.

Johannesburg for Pretoria Day 3

North of Johannesburg, vibrant Pretoria is South Africa's administrative capital, known for its distinctly Afrikaans culture, stunning architecture, and ubiquitous purple-blossomed jacaranda trees.

Visit the monolithic Voortrekker Monument, honoring the mid-19th-century Dutch voortrekkers (pioneers) who migrated from the British-controlled Cape Colony to the inland Highveld region. See the sandstone Union Buildings and the formal garden where Nelson Mandela delivered his historic presidential inauguration speech in 1994. Attend the Captain's Welcome Reception and Dinner.

Johannesburg for Soweto

Day 4

Follow in the footsteps of Nobel Peace Prize laureate Nelson Mandela alona Vilakazi Street and visit the house where he lived from 1946 to 1962, a short distance from the former home of fellow Nobel Peace Prize laureate Desmond Tutu. At Johannesburg's poignant

Apartheid Museum, trace South Africa's 21st-century journey to democracy, and gain insight into the realities of township life through powerful artifacts, photographs, and film footage.


Johannesburg/ Victoria Falls

Day 5

Arrive in Victoria Falls and check into the elegant and historic VICTORIA FALLS HOTEL.

Victoria Falls Day 6

Walk the jungle-fringed trail along the edge of UNESCO-inscribed Victoria Falls, one of the



Seven Natural Wonders of the World, Here, the Zambezi River plunges into a narrow, 360-foot gorge—twice the height of Niagara Falls—creating frothy rapids and vaulting a colorful mist into the air.

Victoria Falls/Kasane, Botswana/Namibia Day 7

Watch for elephants, wild dogs, zebras, and giraffes on a game

drive in Chobe National Park. In the afternoon, embark the ZAMBEZI QUEEN, a five-star river boat, to prepare for your cruise along the Chobe River.

Cruising the Chobe River Day 8 and Day 9

Enjoy up-close views of wildlife, including elephant, giraffe, kudu, oryx, and an astounding array of bird species. Discover the unique symbiosis between species such as the Oxpecker and Cape buffalo in this unspoiled ecosystem. Expert local guides will lead aame-viewina river safaris aboard small excursion boats.

Experience a panoramic drive to Cape Point, visit an African Penguin Colony on Boulders



Cape Town/ Cape Winelands Day 13
