

Siegal Lifelong Learning at Case Western Reserve University Presents “When Bias Enters the Clinic: Antisemitism and Anti-Zionism in Modern Medicine”

BEACHWOOD, Ohio — Siegal Lifelong Learning at Case Western Reserve University invites healthcare professionals, educators, students, and community members to participate in “[When Bias Enters the Clinic: Antisemitism and Anti-Zionism in Modern Medicine](#),” a two-part online course offered Thursdays, December 3 and 10, from 1:30 to 3 p.m. ET.

The timely course will explore contemporary manifestations of antisemitism and anti-Zionism in healthcare, mental health and medical education, including their potential impact on Jewish patients, healthcare professionals, medical trainees, and clinical environments. Through expert perspectives and current case studies, participants will examine the intersection of bias and discrimination due to Jewish and Zionist identity and support, in the broad medical profession and its impact on patient care.

The course will be taught by **Sara Colb, JD, Director of Advocacy, National Affairs, Anti-Defamation League**; **Jacqueline Hart, MD, Internist and Co-Lead of the Jewish Employee Resource Group at Mass General Brigham**; and **Eveline Shekhman, MBA, Chief Executive Officer of the American Jewish Medical Association**.

“This course creates an important and timely opportunity to examine how antisemitism and anti-Zionism may intersect with discrimination in healthcare, medical education students, and professional practice,” said **Dafna Ben Yosef, PhD, Director of Jewish Lifelong Learning at Siegal Lifelong Learning**. *“By bringing together expertise in antisemitism advocacy, clinical medicine, and healthcare profession leadership, we hope to increase awareness of this pivotal rising challenge faced by medical professionals and patients, provide participants with an understanding of these issues and consider constructive approaches to addressing them in the workplace or at the community level.”*

The course is offered **in collaboration with the Anti-Defamation League (ADL)** and is designed to foster informed discussion and practical learning about challenges faced by healthcare institutions, professionals, and patients.

Nonmember cost is \$50; Siegal Lifelong Learning members receive a 15% discount. Registration is required.
