

The Post-baccalaureate Research Education Program (CasePREP)

Grooming the Next Generation of Minority PhD & MD/PhD Scientists

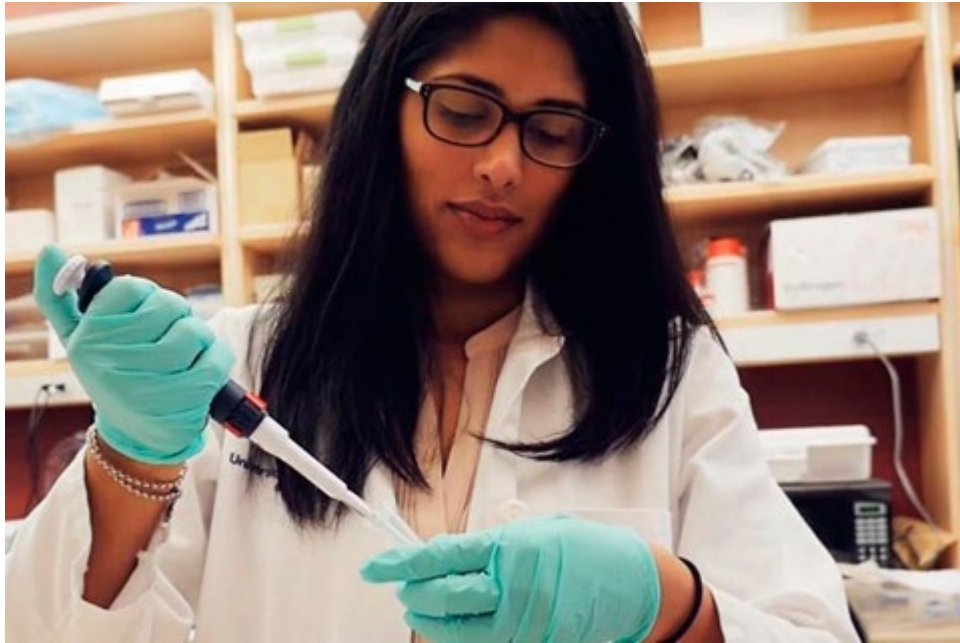
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Program Activities:

- PREP scholars spend 1-2 year working in a lab
- Meeting once a week as a group for coaching on various topics
- Attend and present their research at national meetings
- They are paid \$27,200/yr plus benefits

Cumulative Outcome:

- 86 total Scholars admitted over past 14 cohorts
- 33 males + 53 females (61.6% female)
- 63 of 68 Scholars that entered PhD programs finished degree or are still in PhD programs – **93%**
- **30%** of PREP Scholars entered PhD or MD-PhD at CWRU SOM



- 23 PREP Scholars earned PhD
- 7 entered MD/PhD programs
- 1 PREP Scholar earned MD/PhD
- 2 PREP Scholars in CWRU MSTP

We believe that the development of more minority scientists is integral to addressing health disparities.

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
