Dean's Scholars Program

Postdoctoral Training Program

Our innovative dean's scholars program provides recent PhD graduates from underrepresented populations (as defined by the National Institutes of Health) with a five-year postdoctoral training program that provides educational and research resources for advancement to tenure-track faculty positions at Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine.

Attracting top candidates from both CWRU and peer institutions, the program provides rigorous postdoctoral training and career development training—and a direct pathway to tenure-track faculty positions.

Award:

The fellowship provides a supplement to the postdoc stipend over and above the NIH standards of \$5,000 for the first three years (Step 1) and \$10,000 for years four and five (Step 2). The program also provides the scholar with additional funds for laboratory use (\$15,000 annually for Step 1 and \$40,000 annually for Step 2).
