Postdoctoral Training Program

Our innovative dean's scholars program provides recent PhD graduates from underrepresented populations (as defined by the National Institutes of Health) with a five-year postdoctoral training program that provides educational and research resources for advancement to tenure-track faculty positions at Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine.

Attracting top candidates from both CWRU and peer institutions, the program provides rigorous postdoctoral training and career development training —and a direct pathway to tenure-track faculty positions.

Award:

The fellowship provides a supplement to the postdoc stipend over and above the NIH standards of \$5,000 for the first three years (Step 1) and \$10,000 for years four and five (Step 2). The program also provides the scholar with additional funds for laboratory use (\$15,000 annually for Step 1 and \$40,000 annually for Step 2).
