Guidelines:

- 1) It is not a cut and paste from your CV.
- 2) It does not need to be exhaustive or overly detailed (that level of detail belongs in your ERAS application.
- 3) Utilize the following format:
 - Worked with (faculty research mentor or mentors) from (institution and department)
 - Studied (topic)
 - Resulted in (published manuscripts, oral presentations, poster presentations)
 - Worked with (faculty research mentor or mentors) from (institution and department)
 - Presented a case of (case report topic)
 - Resulted in (published manuscript, oral presentation, or poster presentation)
 - Working with (if project is ongoing) (faculty research mentor or mentors) from (institution and department)
 - Studying (topic)

Examples:

- Worked with Joseph Dohar, MD and Patricia Hebda, PhD at Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh Department of Pediatric Otolaryngology
 - o Studied airway stenosis and scar formation from the CO2 laser in a rabbit airway model
 - Resulted in three published manuscripts, three oral presentations and two poster presentations and national conferences
- Worked with Todd Otteson, MD, MPH from University Hospitals Cleveland Medical Center Department of Otolaryngology
 - o Studied hearing loss in pediatric patients with Enlarged Vestibular Aqueduct
 - Resulted in two published manuscripts with one manuscript currently under review; resulted in two oral presentations and four poster presentations at national conferences
- Working with Todd Otteson, MD, MPH from University Hospitals Cleveland Medical Center Department of Otolaryngology
 - Reporting a case of an anomalous course of the internal carotid artery through the middle ear noted by bleeding at the time of myringotomy and reviewed the literature
 - A manuscript is in preparation
