MSTP Annual Retreat



BIG NEWS!

CWRU School of Medicine established the country's first combined MD-PhD program in 1956. Eight years later, the NIH created the MSTP. In 1975, CWRU School of Medicine received an NIH MSTP T32 and maintained continuous T32 funding for 48 years (T32 GM007250)! In early 2023, under the leadership of former MSTP Director Dr. Cliff Harding, a new multi-PI MSTP T32 grant was submitted under the new RFA. Our program was rated "Exceptional" in the scientific review, and a new 5-year T32 grant began in July, 2024 (T32 GM152319). We are grateful to Dr. Harding's leadership through the grant application process and throughout his tenure as MSTP Director, and we look forward to establishing a strong track record of successes in producing outstanding and productive physician-scientists under the new award!
