

1. MSTP students at this level have completed two years of medical school and are now working toward their PhD in a research lab. They have minimal experience with patient interaction at this level.
2. This elective is the only patient contact they will have for approximately four years.
3. The comfort level with patients varies widely between students.
4. I recommend that you explore both of your comfort levels during your first meeting and determine the pace and depth at which you feel comfortable integrating the student into your clinical work.
5. The student will have "read only" access to EPIC and will not be able to assist with writing notes. They can, however, review notes before clinic to be knowledgeable about the scheduled patients.
6. The students benefit greatly from any feedback you can give them. Taking the time to observe their interview and exam skills, and giving feedback, will help them immensely. While this is not expected every session, any feedback before the end of their elective would be greatly appreciated.
7. This experience is designed to be a longitudinal one, with the MSTP student coming to your office for a short period of time (2-3 hours) once a week during the academic year (Sept 1 - May 1st). If an alternative schedule works better for both of you, feel free to implement it. We expect that the student will spend 30 hours with you each semester, at minimum. If you or the student have to miss a session on occasion, it's not a problem. I do not "take attendance". However, if the student is not making clinical tutorial a priority, or if they are cancelling last minute, please let me know. This is seen as a professionalism issue and I want to know about the issue so it can be handled directly.
8. If there is another experience that you think will provide value for the students (attending hospital rounds or going to a conference), please feel free to substitute this experience *on occasion*. All clinical experience helps with professional development.
