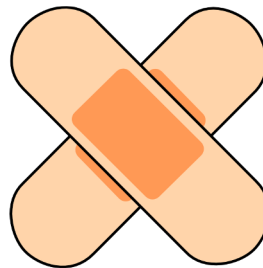
Moving Up In the Phases!

Despite COVID-19's impact in our lives, luckily case rates in Ohio are on the decline. Even though Ohio's rates are lowering, there is still a high incidence rate according to the CDC's guidelines. Cuyahoga county is still at a level 3 advisory level meaning there is more than 100 cases per 100,000 over a two-week period. If you know family or friends who need a vaccine, there is some good news! **On Friday, March 19**, Phase 2C will begin. Those who are **40 years or older are eligible to receive a vaccine**. **On Monday, March 29**, all Ohioans **ages 16 and older will also become eligible to receive vaccines**.

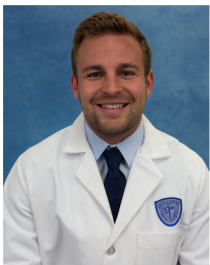
"God Loves a Grunt" is a well-known painting created by Capt. George Skypeck in the early 1980s as a commemoration to Vietnam veterans. This particular work of art holds a special meaning to PAs, especially those who began their careers after serving as medics in the Vietnam War. 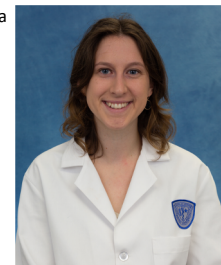
