

Mentoring Committee

All second year students who have not completed his/her comprehensive exams need to form a mentoring committee or have not advanced to candidacy. This committee will have three members, the mentor and two other faculty, at least one of whom has to have a primary appointment in our department and a second with at least a secondary appointment in the department; this can be the mentor. A committee member, who has a primary appointment in the department, but not the mentor, will serve as the chair. At least one member of the committee must have a primary appointment and be in your concentration.

These committees will meet with each student at least once every semester. The purpose of these meetings is to evaluate progress and help students plan their academic and professional trajectories.
