September 20-Oct 9, 2019	Clinical Skills Exam (CSE) 2A
September 2019	Begin thinking about what happens after the end of Block 6: Class Meeting to make choices about March 2020-July 2021 (Step I, Research Block, early clinical rotations)
October 2019	Assignment of 3 rd year clinical schedule, student switches allowed until mid-November
November – December 2019	Lottery for early clinical core rotations (March-July 2020); a small number of students do early cores
Late December 2019	Reminder: Research schedule due 30 days before the start of the Research Block
Jan to Mar 2020	Submit preferences for hospital sites of clinical core rotations, assignments occur 8 weeks before the start of the core with a 1 week period for student switches
Late January 2020	Year 2 Portfolio due
Jan 29-Feb 18, 2020	Block 8 summative CSE 2B
March 6, 2020	Block 6 ends with the NBME Exam. Foundations of Medicine and Health is over!
March-July, 2020	Options: USMLE Step 1 (6 weeks), Research Block (8-16 weeks), early clinical core

July 2020-June 2021	Traditional Clinical Cores 1-4 or Cleveland Clinic Longitudinal Clerkship (CCLC) & research/flexible time
December 31, 2020	Deadline for taking USMLE Step 1
January 2021	Class Meeting about scheduling Acting Internships (AI's) and 4 th year Electives
February 1, 2021	Start scheduling for AI's & Electives that begin in July
February 2021	Class Meeting: Medical Student Performance Evaluation (MSPE) & Electronic Residency Application Service (ERAS)
Dec 2020-Feb 2021	Visiting Student Learning Opportunities (VSLO) opens- Registrar gives access by request
Spring/Summer 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Specialty Choice: Careers in Medicine, CWRU Roadmap to Residency • Individual meeting with your Society Dean to discuss 4th-year scheduling • Update your Curriculum Vitae (CV); preparation for ERAS application and to give to your letter of recommendation (LOR) writers (usually request July-September) • MSPE preparation, starting in March 2021 (3 meetings with your Society Dean to plan 4th year electives and work on your letter) • Personal Statement, interviewing, video interviewing workshops, ERAS photos
Spring-Fall 2021	Register for Early Match Specialties (Ophthalmology , Urology) and Military Matches
February 2021	ERAS token (special email) distributed via email from Registrar; only for LOR's
June 2021	Class Meeting: ERAS 2.0, full myERAS application is open (3 months to finish), CSE 3

September 5-15, 2021	Submit ERAS Application, start applying to specific programs
September 15, 2021	ERAS Application released to programs; programs may contact individual applicants via ERAS for interviews
September 15, 2021	Register with National Residency Matching Program (NRMP) for the Main Residency Match
September 30, 2021	MSPE uploaded to ERAS by the registrar
October 1, 2021	MSPE released to Residency Programs
October 2021	Residency Interviews Start (highly variable amongst specialties Oct-Jan)
November 1, 2021	Deadline for taking USMLE Step 2 CS (schedule early, slots fill quickly)
November 30, 2021	NRMP registration deadline. \$50 late fee afterwards
December 31, 2021	Deadline for taking USMLE Step 2 CK
Mid-December 2021	Military Match
Early January 2022	Urology Match : deadline for submission of rank list, results late-January
January 2022	Ophthalmology Match (SF Match) deadline for submitting rank list, results mid-January
Mid-January 2022	Applicants and programs may start entering their rank order lists in NRMP
Late-January 2022	Residency Interviews End
February 28, 2022	Deadline for submitting MD Thesis
Late February 2022	Final NRMP rank order list due for applicants and programs
March 14, 2022	SOAP (Supplemental Offer and Accept Program) Begins- only for unmatched students
March 18, 2022	Match Day
April – May 2022	Sign the contract with your residency program
May 15, 2022	Medical School Graduation and university commencement
Mid-June 2022	Residency begins
