We are proud to host minority and underrepresented students through our David Satcher Clerkship. The David Satcher Clerkship allows students to do electives at our hospital, offers mentorship, exposure to career opportunities available in academic medical centers, and a significant stipend to cover the elective costs.

David Satcher was the first African American to graduate with his MD Ph.D. from the Case Medical Science Training Program. He was the 16th Surgeon General of the United States and former Secretary for Health in the Department of Health and Human Services. His public service tenure also includes serving as Director of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention from 1993 to 1998.

University Hospitals created a national model for the recruitment of **underrepresented minority medical students (US citizens only)** as assurance that the diversity of future generations of healthcare leaders receives accurate representation, and as its pledge that the needs of the underserved and underrepresented ethnic communities will be met.

The David Satcher Clerkship hosts between 10 and 15 minority medical students annually. Clerkships are offered for a maximum of 4-weeks, available July through October only. Block times may be flexible if necessary. Application processing fees are held when eligible students apply for the David Satcher Clerkship.
