



Creating a position:

In order to route for approval, the department administrator must create the position listing in Interfolio. This includes submitting the position description, qualifications, application instructions (including applicant-required documents), evaluation criteria, search committee members, **and attaching the forms listed below.**

- A. [Request to Initiate Faculty Search for Full-Time Faculty Form](#): This form includes pertinent information such as the title and rank of the requested position, description of responsibilities, salary and funding information, the search committee chair(s), justification for the position, and how the hire will contribute to the department's commitment to diversity. *There can only be ONE hire per SOM faculty search number. Please submit multiple search forms if the department wishes to hire for multiple positions for the same listing.*
- B. **Forms 1+2 for OIDEO**: These forms can be found at the top of [OIDEO's Forms and Downloads Page](#)

1. To create a new position, go to the “Positions” page along the left side of the home screen then click “New Position”.


2. When creating a position for faculty please select “Open Rank/Track Faculty” as the type and select your department for the unit.



3. Start filling out the Basic Information section. “Open Date” is the date you would like the position to publish. Please be mindful when choosing your open date since the position will need to go through a five-step approval process before it’s posted.

****Please note: If the position is approved before the chosen publish date, then the position will automatically be published and viewable to applicants on the publish date. If the position is approved after the chosen publish date, the department administrator must go into Interfolio and publish the position.**

4. The *Basic Information* section includes Position Title, Location, Open Date, Deadline selection, Position Description, Qualifications, Application Instructions, and Advertising Setting.

5. Once all basic information is filled out, you can continue to the *Required Documents* section and add all documents you would like applicants to upload. **Please Note: To add an optional document, you must first add it as 1 required. You may then edit the requirement by clicking the pencil and then changing the 1 to 0.**

7. *Application Forms* can be created using the "Administration" tab along the left side of the screen, then clicking "Application Forms". It is recommended to do this before you start creating your position as forms cannot be created at this step, only added to the position. Please only create Application Forms for your department.

The EEO Form was created by OIDEO and is required to include in the position.

8. In the *Search Committee* section you will add all search committee members. Please note that training is required to be a search committee member. While the lack of training will not delay the position approval process, members/administrators must work with Karyn Newton separately to obtain training **before interviewing applicants**.

*Interfolio automatically inputs the position creator as the Committee Manager. You can remove yourself after adding another Manager using the “Add Manager” button.



If these forms are not attached, the position will be sent back to the Administrator for revision.**




10. After completing the *Position Notes* section, you will view the *Position Summary*. Please ensure that all information is correct and then “Submit for Approval”.

Approval process overview:

Once you've created your position and submit for approval, it will follow the process below.

Step Name

☰ Faculty Affairs Initial Review

☰ Research Approval

☰ Finance Approval

☰ OIDEO Approval (Forms 1 & 2)

☰ Faculty Affairs Final Approval

1. FA Initial review - is the information complete and is the current form being used

2. Research Approval - how does the hire align with the department's strategic plan

3. Finance approval - based on OPR codes/percentage and for the duration of the faculty term

4. OIDEO - will require meeting with Heather Burton and the chair of the search committee before approval

5. FA Final Approval - Confirm Provost approval by ECC

After the position has been approved, Interfolio will notify the creator of the position via email. **Please note: If the position is approved before the chosen publish date, then the position will automatically be published and viewable to applicants on the publish date. **If the position is approved after the chosen publish date**, the department administrator must go into Interfolio and publish the position.

Looking Ahead:

Offer Letters:

Once a candidate is identified, the department should draft an offer letter (in Word format) and email it to cynthia.kim@case.edu, along with the Position ID, candidate's CV, and the SOM Faculty Recruitment Startup Calculation Spreadsheet (if applicable). The letter will then be routed for approval by SOM senior administration, the Dean, and the Provost. A final draft of the letter will be emailed back to the department for review before it is sent out to the candidate for signature via DocuSign. If you have questions regarding the offer letter process or require an offer letter template, please reach out to cynthia.kim@case.edu.

Faculty Appointments:

Once an offer letter has been signed. Department Administrators should submit a New Appointment packet to the Office of Faculty Affairs.
