What is LAMP?

LAMP is a faculty development program for early career faculty, typically in years 2-4 of a faculty appointment. It consists of monthly **in-person workshops** covering the fundamentals of career planning, self-awareness and self-management, as well as core leadership skills. The program is designed to help faculty members succeed in academic medicine through improved abilities in time management, negotiation, mentor identification, self-efficacy, career satisfaction, and academic promotion.

- Promotion and Tenure
- Academic Career Planning
- Time Management
- Conflict Management
- Negotiation Skills
- Managing Teams
- Presenting Your Work
- Media Training
