Membership Terms: The CBR will be chaired by a faculty member appointed jointly by the Dean and the Chair of Faculty Council, preferably a department chair or center director. A vice-chair will be elected by the faculty. Additional voting members of the CBR will include four faculty members appointed by the Dean, four elected faculty members from SOM Basic Science Departments; and one elected faculty member from each of the four affiliated hospitals. The total number of members on the CBR will be 14 (9 elected and 5 appointed). The Dean and Vice-Dean for Research will be ex officio non-voting members of the CBR. Term of Service for members of the CBR will be 4 years. Members shall serve for a period of four years. Representatives may serve two consecutive terms (for a total of 8 years) and may be eligible to serve again after an absence of one year.

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
