Membership Terms: The Program Review Committee shall consist of eight full-time members of the School of Medicine faculty, elected at-large by the full-time faculty, with no more than two members from a single department, and three ex officio members. The elected members shall serve staggered three-year terms, two or three new members being elected each year. Elected members may stand for re-election and serve at most two consecutive terms. All elected and ex officio members shall be voting members on the committee. The Chair of the Faculty Council shall appoint one of the elected members to serve on an annual basis as Chair of the committee after soliciting recommendations from its members.

The committee shall be composed of:

- (a) three elected members of the Faculty involved in graduate or undergraduate education in the School of Medicine,
- (b) five elected faculty members currently in charge of on-going graduate or undergraduate programs involving departments of the School of Medicine, elected by the Faculty of Medicine
- (c) one School of Medicine faculty member serving on the University Faculty Senate Committee on Graduate Studies (ex officio),
- (d) one School of Medicine faculty member serving on the University Faculty Senate Committee on Undergraduate Education (ex officio), and
- (e) the Vice Dean for Graduate Education (ex officio).
