Focus on vascular surgery

Our vascular surgeons offer leading minimally invasive therapies for aortic disease, including endovascular aortic repair (EVAR) and thoracic endovascular aortic repair (TEVAR). The team also specializes in autologous stem cell therapy to prevent amputation in patients with severe arterial disease, and carotid surgery and stenting for extracranial cerebrovascular disease.

Specialized services:

- Treatment of aortic pathologies, cerebrovascular disease and peripheral occlusive disease
- Complex aortic and/or peripheral reconstruction, revascularization or aneurysm repair
- Endovascular treatment of thoracic and abdominal aneurysms
- Percutaneous interventions, including angioplasty, thrombolysis and stenting of peripheral vessels
