The adult-gero NP major, as part of FPB's MSN program, requires 41 credit hours of coursework, plus about 600 hours of clinicals. The coursework is usually completed within 18 months (four semesters), and courses are offered in a distance-friendly format that requires about eight trips to Cleveland for full-time students.
