
PNP-AC Fast Facts

- This major is designed to be completed dually with the pediatric primary care track and is also offered as a post-graduate certificate program for NPs with existing certification in pediatrics
- Begin core MSN classes any term.
 Clinical courses begin every Fall, and students can complete the program in 2 years full time, or 3-5 years part time
- Distance-friendly options available with 3-4 trips to campus per term
- 51 credit hours for completion of dual PNP program
- Graduates are eligible for the certification exam conducted by the Pediatric Nursing Certification Board
- Applicants must have at least 1 year of recent acute care (hospital-based) pediatric nursing experience and PALS certification prior to starting PNP-AC clinical rotations.
